  - Pre-approved mileage and/or transportation costs will be reimbursed (Board Directors also receive a complimentary annual Ontario Parks pass that can be used in any provincial park)
- Participate in committee meetings approximately four times a year (usually by conference call) and contribute to the activities of the committee
